Renowned composer Tom Hodge, an Ivor Novello nominee, stands at the forefront of shaping contemporary soundscapes for both drama and beyond. His gripping score for Kevin Macdonald's acclaimed feature film THE MAURITANIAN, starring Tahar Rahim, Jodie Foster, and Benedict Cumberbatch, is a testament to his artistry.

In 2019, Tom received an Ivor Novello nomination for his score in the BBC/PBS historical docu-miniseries RISE OF THE NAZIS, now in its fourth season for 72 Films. He has continued his collaboration with Oscar-winner Kevin Macdonald providing music for the documentaries HIGH & LOW: JOHN GALLIANO, KLITSCHKO: MORE THAN A FIGHT, and the Academy-long-listed LAST SONG FROM KABUL.

Notable among his drama credits is the score for the prestigious BBC/AMC crime drama series MCMAFIA, starring James Norton. And Tom co-scored director Christian Schwochow's feature JE SUIS KARL with electronic artist Floex, available on Netflix.

Showcasing his versatility, Tom provided the score for the recent adaptation of the drama THE IPCRESS FILE for Altitude Television, starring Joe Cole, Tom Hollander, and Lucy Boynton.

A virtuoso pianist and clarinetist, Tom stands as a preeminent artist pushing the boundaries of experimental neoclassical music. His contributions extend across feature films, documentaries, TV dramas, ballet productions, and numerous award-winning advertising campaigns, cementing his position as a leading figure in the world of original scores.
